He lectures for medical students on *The Organisation of the Health Care System in the Netherlands* He is co-operating for a long period with the Safarik University in Kosice, and from 2011 on with the Palacky University in Olomouc. His collaborative research in the Safarik University focuses on *Inequality in Health in Adolescents* and on *Chronically Ill and their integration in society*. He was one of the founders of the Central European Network and of the Kosice Institute for Society and Health.
